Geography:

As part of our learning about the Geography of the British Isles, we will be exploring different cities and their sporting histories.

Can you name up to 6 UK cities and identify them?

Can you explain the difference between the British Isles, Great Britain and the United Kingdom.



Understanding physical development, health and well-being

In P.E. we will be developing our gymnastic abilities. In PSHE the children will be learning about setting goals and how to effectively achieve them.

Can you perform actions, balances and body shapes with agility and control?

Can you take time to consider your experiences and decide what needs to be done next?

Reading

The Children will be asked to develop their awareness of how vocabulary can impact on the reader.

Can explain the difference that adjectives and verbs make?

Writing

This term we will be writing adventure stories using direct speech.

Computing

In computing the children will continue to learn about how they can be safe and effective communicators.

During this topic we will be learning the names and locations of the United Kingdom's main cities. To do this, we will be exploring the major sporting venues, significant landmarks and tourist attractions located within those cities.

Through our exploration of sporting venues, we will also be investigating measurements and exploring the different lines and shapes that we find within these.

So when answering our topic question "Who do you support?" we are expecting the children to be able to give detailed answers including the location and description of the sports ground or venue.

Understanding the Arts

In Art, the children will be taking inspiration from Lowry to create scenes of British cities.

Mathematical Understanding

This term the children will be focusing on mastering and broadening their knowledge of addition and subtraction

Can you add and subtract with up to 3 digits using a formal written method?

Can you solve problems including missing number problems?

Scientific and Technological Understanding

In Science the children will be exploring the growth of plants and in which conditions they grow best in.

Can you identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants? (roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers)?

Can you explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow)?
